Visit to Bank of England Museum and LIBF University - Year 12

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Bank of England Museum and LIBF University on Thursday 2nd February 2023. The aim of this visit is to inform the students of the operation of monetary policy at the Bank of England.

Students will meet inside Uxbridge underground station at 8.20am sharp and travel by tube. Students will be required to wear school smart, professional dress and comfortable walking shoes. Students may require a packed lunch for this trip, however there will be an opportunity for them to purchase their own lunch in the cafés around the Bank of England, if they wish to. Students will require their travel card and this should be topped up with funds sufficient for the return journey. Students will be released from Monument, in order to make their own way home. If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

There is no cost for this trip, however if you would like your child to attend please complete the consent form on ParentPay.

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
