## Visit to St Anne's College, University of Oxford - Year 10

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to St Anne's College, which is part of the University of Oxford, on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The aim of this visit is for students to look around a higher education destination, discover what a destination like Oxford can offer and learn more about the application process.

Students will leave the school at 8.30am on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and travel by coach to and from the St Anne's College, returning to school at 4.30pm. Students will be required to wear full school uniform, including shoes, no jeans or trainers allowed. Students will be provided with lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that although the invitation to attend this trip is based on student's academic ability and behaviour, there are still a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
