### Visit to the Balloon Museum – Year 10

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Balloon Museum on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2024. This is a rewards trip for students in Year 10. Students will visit the Emotion Air exhibition; this immersive art experience will increase students' cultural capital.

Students will leave the school at 9am on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and travel by train to and from the Balloon Museum, returning to school at 3pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black leather-like shoes. Students will also require packed lunch for this trip, along with a valid travel card, topped up with enough funds for the return journey to central London.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available, and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £15.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £15.00, before Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to [finance@uhs.org.uk](mailto:finance@uhs.org.uk).

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
