Uniform and Equipment — Academic Year 2026–2027

At Uxbridge High School, we take great pride in our uniform. It gives every student a sense of belonging and a visible identity as part of the UHS community. We ask all students to wear their uniform to the highest standard, what we call our Gold Standard, and we encourage families to share in this pride as your child begins, or continues, their journey with UHS.

Our Gold Standard

Gold Standard means students are always:

- Wearing their blazer during the school day
- Wearing their tie at the correct length
- Wearing their skirt at the correct length
- Presenting themselves positively and in full uniform

Wearing the correct uniform helps remove distractions, supports a sense of comfort and equality and keeps every student focused on their learning.

School Uniform from September 2026

Years 7 to 9 — Compulsory Navy Uniform

Students in Years 7 to 9 must wear the new navy uniform. The full list of required items is as follows:

- **Navy blazer** with school crest and gold trim
- **Navy tie** with gold crest
- **Collared plain white shirt**
- **Navy pleated skirt with gold trim** (if wearing a skirt)
- **Plain navy or charcoal trousers** (no leggings, jeans or tight-fitting trousers - please refer to our uniform supplier for approved styles)
- **Plain navy or charcoal tailored shorts** (must be tailored, no sports shorts, cycling shorts, denim or tight-fitting shorts)
- **Plain navy socks or tights**
- **Plain black leather-look shoes only** (canvas shoes or trainers are not permitted)
- **Smart outdoor coat, dark in colour** (leather, leather-look, denim, hoodies and sweatshirts are not permitted; large logos or writing are not allowed)

Optional: Navy jumper with school crest and gold trim. Please see the 'Blazer and Jumper' section below for important information about this item.

Years 10 and 11 — Uniform Transition

Students in Years 10 and 11 may continue to wear the current black uniform during the 2026–2027 academic year. However, the black uniform is being phased out and stock is no longer being replenished. Some items are already unavailable.

If you are purchasing any new uniform items over the summer, we strongly encourage you to buy the new navy uniform rather than black. Remaining black uniform items are available at a discounted price whilst stocks last. Year 10 and 11 students are also welcome to switch to the full navy uniform at any point, as many students already have.

The current black uniform items are:

- Black blazer with school crest
- Collared plain white shirt (worn with trousers and school tie)
- Open neck plain white shirt (worn with pleated tartan skirt and school pin)
- Black jumper with school crest
- Plain black trousers (no leggings, jeans or tight-fitting trousers)
- Plain black tailored shorts (must be tailored)
- Pleated tartan skirt (knee or long length)
- School house tie or house pin (for students wearing the tartan skirt)
- Plain black socks or tights
- Plain black leather-look shoes
- Smart outdoor coat, dark in colour

Blazer and Jumper

The blazer is a compulsory item and must be always worn. Students who choose to wear the optional branded school jumper must also wear their blazer over it, the jumper cannot be worn as a substitute for the blazer and jumpers which do not have the school logo on them are not permitted.

Please also be aware that the navy jumper with school crest will be discontinued from September 2026 and will not be restocked by our supplier. Remaining stock is currently available at a discounted price whilst supplies last. Students who already own the jumper may continue to wear it, subject to the blazer rule above.

PE Kit

The branded training top with school crest is a compulsory item and must be purchased from our official supplier. For the optional additional PE items, such as the multisport top, football shorts, skort, leggings, training pants and quarter-zip top, parents may choose either the branded version from our supplier or a plain alternative purchased elsewhere. We would encourage you to check SWI Schoolwear first, as their items are competitively priced and are often cheaper than supermarket alternatives.

Important: If you purchase optional PE items from outside our official stockist, they must be completely plain with no logos, branding or writing of any kind. Items should be navy for students in Years 7 to 9, students in Year 10 and 11 can continue to wear the black kit.

All students require football boots with moulded rubber or plastic studs (firm or soft ground). Metal studs, blades and AstroTurf trainers are not permitted, as students use our indoor 3G AstroTurf pitch.

Jewellery, Make-Up and Appearance

Students in Years 7 to 11 are not permitted to wear make-up. Nail varnish, false nails and false eyelashes are also not permitted. Students may wear one wristwatch and small stud or small

sleeper earrings only; hooped earrings and additional jewellery are not permitted. Items that are not permitted may be confiscated until the end of the half term.

Essential Equipment

Every student must arrive at school fully equipped for every lesson. Being well prepared prevents disruption to learning and allows teachers to make the most of every lesson. Each student should carry:

- Post and prep booklet (provided by school)
- 2 black pens and 1 green pen
- Coloured pencils
- Eraser and pencil sharpener
- 1 highlighter pen
- 30cm ruler
- Glue stick
- Geometry set
- Scientific calculator
- Pencil case (please note that students require a clear pencil case in KS4 for exams)

Please note that Tippex and other correction fluids are not permitted in school. Pencil cases and stationery sets can be purchased via Arbor at very low cost and will be distributed to students in form time.

Uniform Expectations and Consequences

We ask all students and families to take responsibility for ensuring uniform is correct every day. If a student is missing an item of uniform for any reason, they should bring a note explaining why and when the matter will be resolved.

Please be aware that if a student arrives at school without the correct uniform and without a satisfactory explanation, they may be sent home to rectify the issue before returning.

Mobile Phones — Yondr Pouches

Uxbridge High School is a phone-free school. All students are required to store their mobile phone in a Yondr pouch for the duration of the school day. Every student will be provided with their first Yondr pouch free of charge. If a student loses or damages their pouch, a replacement must be purchased via Arbor.

Thank you for your continued support in upholding our uniform standards. We are proud of our school community and the way our students represent UHS, and we look forward to a fantastic year ahead.
