**A-level results day - Thursday 13 August 2026**

A-level and equivalent results will be available Thursday 13 August. Students can collect their results from the Small Activity Studio in our Lancaster Building between 8.30am and 1pm. We would like to encourage them to come in to celebrate with their peers, and teachers.

Students should bring photo ID with them; this can be their Sixth Form card.

In most cases, applicants can check whether they have been accepted at their chosen university by signing into UCAS Track. The two links below will be the most useful on results day.
