Visit to Cambridge Theatre, London – Year 8

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Cambridge Theatre, London on Wednesday, 15th April 2026. The aim of this visit is to support Year 8 students in their transition into the Year 9 Musical Theatre Scheme of Work, while broadening their listening experience in preparation for KS4 Music, where students are required to study music for stage and screen.

Students will leave the school at 12:30pm on Wednesday, 15th April 2026 and travel by coach to and from the Cambridge Theatre, returning to school at 5.30pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £41. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £41, before Thursday, 26 March 2026. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use your Arbor Parent Portal to pay for this trip. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to finance@uhs.org.uk.
