Dear parents/carers

I am writing to thank you for your support following our letter last week regarding social media posts encouraging young people to meet after school.

We are very grateful to parents who shared information with us and who spoke with their children to reinforce the importance of going straight home at the end of the school day on Monday. Your cooperation played an important role in helping us keep students safe.

We would like to reassure you that there were no reports of any incidents involving our students on Monday. There was a visible police presence in the areas mentioned in the online posts, and the police also supported local schools with student dismissal, including at our school.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and work with our police partners and other local schools. As part of our ongoing safeguarding arrangements, staff are positioned at key points outside the school at the end of each school day, as they are routinely, to support a safe and orderly dismissal.

We would also ask that parents continue to monitor their child's use of social media, including the content they are viewing, sharing or being sent, and to remind them of the importance of making safe and responsible choices online.

All school activities for the remainder of the week are scheduled to go ahead as normal. Once again, thank you for your vigilance, cooperation and continued support. Keeping our students safe is always our highest priority, and this is most effective when school and families work together.
