Visit to Kia Oval Surrey County Cricket Club - Year 8 & 9

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Kia Oval Surrey County Cricket Club, Kennington, on Monday, 30th June 2025. Students will attend the Kia Oval School's Day, where they will have the opportunity to watch professional a professional cricket match and take part in a wide range of activities, such as shoot 4 goal inflatables, face-painting, meeting animals from Vauxhall City Farm, scavenger hunt (with prizes to be won!). There will also be an autograph station where students will have the opportunity to meet the players and mascots Caesar & Cleo!

Students will leave the school at 8.30am on Monday, 30th June 2025 and travel by train to and from the Kia Oval Surrey County Cricket Club, returning to school at 3.15pm. Students are required to wear school PE Kit and bring a packed lunch for this trip. Please make sure your child has a valid travel card topped up with enough funds for the return journey.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available, and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.
