Year 10 Work Shadowing Week: Monday 17th November – Friday 21st November 2025

We are pleased to offer your child the opportunity to take part in Work Shadowing Week, which will take place from **Monday 17th to Friday 21st November 2025.**

Work shadowing gives students first hand insight into the world of work. It helps them understand daily responsibilities and professional expectations, and how their education links to future careers. The experience aims to spark career interest while also developing students' awareness of essential workplace skills and etiquette.

During this week, students are encouraged to spend time in a workplace of your choice. This could be the place of work of a parent, relative, friend or neighbour. Please note that you will be responsible for arranging the placement.

While the placement may not reflect your child's dream job, the goal is to provide a meaningful experience to working life - every experience, regardless of the field, can offer valuable insights.

Throughout the placement, we hope students will have the opportunity to:

- Meet a range of people completing different jobs or tasks each day
- Talk to employees about their career journeys
- Meet people with different levels of responsibility across the organisation
