Visit to GCSE Maths in Action Day, Emmanuel Centre, London SW1 - Year 10

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the GCSE Maths in Action Day at the Emmanuel Centre, London SW1 on Friday $1^{\rm st}$ March 2024. The goal of the Maths in Action Day is to help students deepen their understanding of key mathematical concepts, improve their problem-solving skills and generate excitement for all things maths! Students will also attend a GCSE masterclass, which is designed to provide them with the knowledge and the key skills they require to excel in their GCSE maths exams.

Students will leave the school at 8.40am on Friday 1st March and travel by train to and from the Emmanuel Centre, returning to school at 4.45pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black leather like shoes. Students are required to bring a pencil case with full equipment, they will also need a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available, and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £22.20. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £22.20, before Wednesday, 31 January 2024. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to finance@uhs.org.uk.

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
