## Visit to CERN - Geneva, Switzerland - Year 12



I am writing to inform you about a school visit to CERN, Geneva, Switzerland from Tuesday 23 July 2024 to Thursday 25 July 2024. This visit will improve student's cultural awareness. Students will visit CERN, the Red Cross & Crescent Museum, and have a tour of the United Nations. At CERN, the European Organisation for Nuclear Research, physicists and engineers use the world's largest and most complex instruments to study the basic constituents of matter – the fundamental particles.

Students will meet UHS staff at Heathrow Airport at 5am on Tuesday  $23^{\rm rd}$  July and travel by plane to and from the Geneva, Switzerland, returning to Heathrow Airport at 6.20pm on Thursday  $25^{\rm th}$  July. Students are required to have a passport valid for at least 3 months after the return day. Accommodation is half board, breakfast and dinner are included; however your child will require additional money for any other snacks and drinks they wish to purchase. Further information regarding this trip will be provide closer to the date.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

The cost of this trip is £600.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable deposit of £150.00, before Thursday  $29^{th}$  February 2024. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip and all subsequent payments (also non-refundable) must be made by the dates set out below: Second instalment of £150.00 by Friday  $29^{th}$  March 2024 Third instalment of £150.00 by Tuesday  $30^{th}$  April 2024 Balance of £150.00 by Friday  $31^{st}$  May 2024

It is your responsibility as parent/guardian to ensure that your child has a valid passport, medical card (EHIC/GHIC) and Visa (if your child is a non-EU citizen).

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account.
