Visit to Sky Studios – Years 10 and 11

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Sky Studios, Brentford on Thursday 26th October. This is the UK headquarters of Sky, there are over 8 studios, and it is here where the majority of football and sports programmes are made. This is a unique experience for students, who will have a behind the scenes tour of Sky studios and a hands-on learning experience creating their own TV content.

Students will leave the school at 8.30am on Thursday 26th October and travel by minibus to and from Sky Studios, returning to school at approximately 12.15pm. As the visit takes place during half term, students are permitted to wear their own clothes.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £2.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £2.00, before Wednesday 25th October.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to finance@uhs.org.uk.

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
