Concessionary prices for families receiving Universal Credit

Reduced prices per school term:

- Price per term: £22.35
- Instrument hire per term: £9.60

You pay the reduced rates if you:

- get Universal Credit and your household income from employment is less than £617 per month
- meet any other criteria for your child to receive free school meals (i.e. you receive income support, income based jobseekers' allowance or if you receive child tax credit with an income below £16,190 (but do not receive working tax credit).
