Assessment Overview

The course is assessed through a combination of exams and practical work:

- **Component 1: Performance** (30% of the qualification)
You will perform two pieces of music, one solo and one ensemble, with a total performance time of at least 4 minutes.
 - **Component 2: Composition** (30% of the qualification)
Compose two pieces: one to a brief and the other a free composition of your choice.
 - **Component 3: Listening and Appraising Exam** (40% of the qualification)
This exam tests your ability to understand and analyse music from a variety of genres, as well as your knowledge of key musical elements.
